### Question

**To ask the Minister for Health if her Department and each agency or public body under its remit uses a formal contract management system or procurement tracking platform; to list the systems in use; and if they are centrally monitored or independently operated. -Albert Dolan**

### Response

Dear Deputy Dolan,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

HSE Procurement currently utilises a procurement & tender management system not a contract management system which tracks the progress of HSE requirements from receipt of customer request, through the publication & evaluation of the project, to the award where the successful supplier(s), the timeframe & the estimated value of any contract is captured. The system is named the Procurement Project Management System (PPMS) and is centrally monitored and maintained by HSE Strategic Sourcing.

The roll out of the new Integrated Financial Management System throughout the HSE in 2025 will provide real time expenditure and purchasing activity data to assist with contract performance and management initiatives. In addition, HSE Procurement intends to shortly source a technical solution for upstream procurement processes capable of integrating with IFMS and the government tenders portal whilst delivering procurement project management, data analysis, tender management and contract information solutions.
