Re: The plans in place for outreach centres for the National Rehabilitation Hospital to help those recovering from serious injury and stroke

Dear Deputy Daly,

We acknowledge receipt of your enquiry regarding outreach centres at the NRH.

The National Clinical Programme for Rehabilitation Medicine Model of Care for the Provision of Specialist Rehabilitation in Ireland describes the framework for the development of specialist rehabilitation services in Ireland. The model of care describes the framework for the development of specialist rehabilitation services in Ireland using a tiered approach Level 1 Complex Tertiary (NRH), Level 2 Specialist Rehabilitation (Royal Hospital Donnybrook, Peamount) and community neurorehab teams (CNRTs) with one CNRT in each RHA.

Managed Clinical Rehabilitation Networks will connect acute and post-acute rehabilitation units, community specialist rehabilitation clinicians & community-based services in a formal way to allow delivery of co-ordinated and integrated rehabilitation for patients. The managed clinical rehabilitation network implementation is underway through the HSE.
