Based on the data available, the National Ambulance Service was allocated 161 WTE posts as per the 2024 National Service Plan. This number rose to 191 when including the overhang of approved posts from 2022 and 2023. The National Ambulance Service allocation within the 2025 National Service Plan has not yet been formally allocated and confirmed.
