Tipperary; if she will provide a breakdown of each day that the ShannonDoc service did not open during its' advertised opening hours between 1st January 2024 and 4th March 2025, in tabular form; and if she will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy O'Meara,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Please see below the operating times for the ShannonDoc Treatment Centres (including Roscrea) in Nth. Tipperary as per the ShannonDoc website:

Please note: The Treatment Centres at Roscrea and Thurles are Regional Treatment Centres and while there is a doctor assigned to these areas, they may not be onsite at all times, as they could be carrying out a home visit or attending a patient in a nursing home. Following clinical triage, the patient will be offered an appointment at their local Regional Treatment Centre or at the Core Treatment Centre (Nenagh), where there is a doctor on duty at all times available to see patients if and when required.



ShannonDoc confirmed that every patient who contacts the Out of Hours Service will receive a full clinical assessment by the Nurse, free of charge. Following clinical triage by the nurse the patient will be offered an appointment at their local Regional Treatment Centre or the Core Treatment Centre. Alternatively, ShannonDoc will arrange a home visit or virtual consultation if it is deemed more appropriate for the patient.

In addition, where there are increased demands in certain areas or at certain times, support teams can be deployed from other locations providing an overall borderless service and ensuring services are provided where most needed. The delivery of quality clinical care remains the priority for ShannonDoc Out of Hours Service.

ShannonDoc have confirmed that the Treatment Centre in Roscrea was not closed on any day during the period queried above, 1st January 2024 to 4th March 2025, when it was scheduled to be in operation.

I trust the above information addresses the issues raised in your representation.
