HSE Dublin and North East has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

As part of our quality assurance framework, there is a robust audit process for completed Radiology diagnostics. An above average error rate was noted on reports completed by one Radiologist. This prompted a wider review which is currently ongoing. All patients effected by the review to date have been contacted.
