**PQ 13039/25\* To ask the Minister for Health the position regarding plans for a building (details supplied: Former Camolin Health Centre, Main Street, Camolin, Co. Wexford); and if she will make a statement on the matter. -Brian Brennan**

Dear Deputy Brennan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The former Health Centre Camolin, Co. Wexford is surplus to HSE requirements and is on the HSE Property Disposal Register.

In line with the HSE Property Protocol and the Department of Public Expenditure, NDP Delivery and Reform Circular 11/15: Protocols for the Transfer and Sharing of State Property Asset, the HSE has received an expression of interest from Wexford County Council.

The HSE has been informed by Wexford County Council that an audit of the site is being carried out to assess the viability of same. The audit is expected to be finalised in Q2, 2025; and subsequent to this Wexford County Council will inform the HSE on whether the intention is pursue the option of acquiring the property.
