I refer to your recent correspondence. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position of Cavan Monaghan Mental Health Service.

Early intervention in Psychosis is not available in Cavan Monaghan Mental Health Service, information packs are not being given to family members of people attending the Service.

The 2025 service plan for Cavan Monaghan Mental Health includes the progression of the development of an Early Intervention Psychosis service in both Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service [CAMHS] and Adult Mental Health Service. Cavan Monaghan plan to develop a business submission plan to the national clinical programme under the Expression of Interest.
