**PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of people in each CHO area who are waiting on initial CAMHS services, 0-6months, 6-12months 12-18months, 18+months, in tabular form; and if she will make a statement on the matter. -Aindrias Moynihan**

Dear Deputy Moynihan

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

CAMHS provide specialist mental health service to those aged up to 18 years, who have reached the threshold for a diagnosis of moderate to severe mental health disorder that require the input of multi-disciplinary mental health teams.

The table below provides the latest available information on the number of children and young people waiting to be seen by CAMHS as at the end of **February 2025**. Please be advised that this data is preliminary and subject to change and amendment pending ongoing review and validation prior to publication on the HSE website. Age range is not captured. Please be advised The Health Service Executive no longer collect data by CHO but instead by Health Region.
