**To ask the Minister for Health in relation to the ADMiRE Clinic of CAMHS, the reason for delay in accessing an assessment from the service; what actions are being taken to ensure timely assessments for those who require them; and if she will make a statement on the matter.**

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Dear Deputy Ó Broin,

I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Service endeavours to ensure that routine cases are seen within the recommended timeframe. However, this is not always possible due to the number of referrals accepted by the team, the nature and urgency of referrals accepted, the caseload carried by the team and the resources available to the team at any point in time.

At present there are currently 193 referrals and the wait is approx. 15 – 18 months.
