PQ9558/25-To ask the Minister for Health the number of days in 2024 on which ICU occupancy exceeded 90%, 95%, and 100%, at each relevant public hospital, including statutory and voluntary, across the State, in tabular form.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

Thank you for your representation. Please find the data below prepared by the National Office of Clinical Audit (NOCA) using information from the ICU Bed Information System (ICU-BIS).

This data is from each HSE-funded adult public hospital, the number of days in 2024 during which ICU occupancy exceeded 90%, 95%, and 100%.

The number of days has been calculated based on instances where the occupancy percentage exceeded each of the specified thresholds.

ICU bed occupancy rates from the ICU Bed Information System are captured once daily at 10 am. More detailed occupancy data will be available from the Irish National ICU Audit (INICUA) 2023 report which is currently finalised for agreement and will then be published.
