Dear Deputy Ó Broin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 21978/25), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

All community pharmacies in Ireland hold a Community Pharmacy Contractor Agreement for the provision of services which includes dispensing under the various Community Drug Schemes in Ireland. This includes the GMS Scheme. The agreement is published online at <u>https://www.hse.ie/eng/staff/pcrs/community-pharmacy-contractor-agreement/community-pharmacy-contractor-agreement-booklet-2010.pdf</u>.

Under the GMS and Community Drug Schemes, only one month supply can be provided in line with administrative arrangements. This is set out to the community pharmacy contactors in their handbook and communication via Pharmacy Circular.

Fees are paid in accordance with the Public Service Pay and Pensions Act 2017 (Payments to Community Pharmacy Contractors) Regulations 2019 (as amended).
