Dear Deputy Coppinger,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The National Gender Service is currently based at St Columcille's Hospital (SCH) in Loughlinstown and is a multidisciplinary clinical service for transgender people in Ireland.

The HSE are in the process of finalising the overall schedule of accommodation for the Seamark building.

In the interim, consideration is being given to allocating space in the Vista building on a temporary basis for the National Gender Service. Any decision on the allocation of space for this service remains under the remit of our Regional Health Area service colleagues.
