Dear Deputy Boland,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you with information in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response. I examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Integrated Health Areas of Dublin North County and Dublin North City & West (IHA DNC & DNCW) collates data pertaining to the Assessment of Need (AON) process under the Disability Act, 2005 as per the HSE Operational Guidance System (OGS) which is reported on a quarterly basis. The most recent report available is the end of Quarter 1 2025. Please see the table below with information pertaining to IHA DNC & IHA DNCW overdue AON applications to be completed.

Please note: Overdue AON applications as captured on OGS are categorised by timeframes of:

- Less than 1 month
- 1 3 Months
- Over 3 Months

Overdue applications are calculated based on the statutory timelines of 3 months from start stage 2 and no more than 6 months from the application date.

I may reassure you IHA DNC & IHA DNCW are working to improve the waiting times.
