Dear Deputy Cleere,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 23064/25), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Health Products Regulatory Authority (HPRA) is responsible for co-ordinating the management of shortages of medicines on the Irish market. The HPRA has an existing Medicine Shortages Framework in place to help prevent shortages from occurring and to reduce the impact of shortages on patients by co-ordinating the management of potential or actual shortages as they arise. The HPRA works with a variety of stakeholders including the HSE to respond to potential shortages and reduce the impact of shortages on patients.

Evorel® 50mcg patch and Estradot® patches are reimbursable under Community Drug Schemes and are on the published Reimbursement List. However, there is currently a reported shortage of Estradot® patches, as published on the HPRA website. Where there is a shortage, applications for reimbursement support will be considered for medical card holders under Discretionary Hardship Arrangements.
