Dear Deputy McGrath
Transportation services provided by Tipperary University Hospital are allocated strictly based on medical necessity and not on social, economic, or immigration status.
Eligibility for transportation is determined by the individual's medical condition, mobility criteria and the necessity of travel to access essential healthcare services.
TippUH goal is to ensure that all individuals who meet the medical criteria for this service receive timely and appropriate transportation support, regardless of their background or personal circumstances
