Dear Deputy Ó Snodaigh,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The HSE Capital Plan 2025 includes funding to progress the design of a new Primary Care Centre at Curlew Road, Drimnagh.

The project is presently at Design Stage 2A and the appointed Design Team is developing documents for obtaining statutory approvals ie Planning, Fire Safety Certificate & Disability Access Certificate.

On completion of statutory consent documents, these will be reviewed by HSE stakeholders prior to Dublin City Council.
