Dear Deputy

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to HSE staff Covid absence which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for reply.

Data on all staff absences is collected nationally and is reported monthly as the HSE National Absence Report. This <u>link</u> provides detail on the HSE National Absence Report. This report is published monthly and provides data on all staff absences. National Absence is calculated as a percentage rate based on lost time (hours) over the available time (hours). It is not reported as headcount, but rather as a percentage rate of absence.

The below table provides the latest monthly data available on all staff absence, by staff category and also Care Group level. This data also shows the rate of absence attributing to COVID-19.
