To ask the Minister for Health to clarify during which class school children in Laois are getting their first dental examination appointments; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Stanley

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

The HSE Public Dental Service in Laois is currently calling children who were in 6^{th} class in 2020-2021 for their 6^{th} class examination and routine treatment, including orthodontic assessment. Please see below the table of 6^{th} class waiting list figures correct as of 27/05/2025.

Since July 2024 the dental service in Portlaoise has run two extra evening sessions per week using HSE staff to reduce the 6th class waiting list. To date, 246 children have had their 6th class assessments and treatment completed under this additional scheme.
