To ask the Minister for Health the number of patients in Mayo University Hospital who have been clinically discharged but remain in hospital; and the length of time such patients have been in that situation. -Paul Lawless

Dear Deputy Lawless,

I refer to the above representation;

Mayo University Hospital (MUH) adheres to national policy concerning delayed transfer of care (DTOC) for medically fit patients currently occupying acute beds. As of today, there are 7 such patients, with lengths of stay ranging from 4 to 112 days. These delays are due to various factors, including pending housing adaptations, legal issues, availability of home care staff, and waiting for placements in district care facilities.
