To ask the Minister for Health the supports available for persons who suffer from idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis and require oxygen 24/7; and if she will make a statement on the matter. - Paul McAuliffe

Dear Deputy McAuliffe,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 52464/25), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

A Medical Card from the HSE can cover the cost of a medical oxygen concentrator and other medical appliances.

Everyone without a medical card should apply for a Drugs Payment Scheme (DPS) card.

Having a DPS card means you or your family will pay a maximum of €80 in a calendar month for:

- approved prescribed drugs and medicines
- rental costs for a continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) machine
- rental costs for oxygen
