To ask the Minister for Health the number of resuscitation bays and cubicles currently within the accident and emergency department of Kerry University Hospital and if she will make a statement on the matter – Michael Cahill

Response provided by University Hospital Kerry:

Within the Emergency Department of University Hospital Kerry the following is the arrangement of bays and cubicles.

Majors and Minors comprise twelve bays of nine and three respectively. Additionally, there are four isolation rooms. Paediatric cubicles comprise three with a further one being an isolation room. Resuscitation wise, there are three cubicles in the Unit with one being Paediatric orientated. Also within the Emergency Department is an eight by Acute Medical Unit.
