Dear Deputy Cahill,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

As previously communicated, the provision of a Primary Care facility was planned on the grounds of Áras Phádraig site as a joint venture with Kerry County Council.

The failure of the planning permission application for the provision of the Killarney Primary Care facility on the grounds of Áras Phádraig site, is a setback to the provision of this facility for the people of Killarney.

The HSE is now considering other options for the provision of this Primary Care Centre in Killarney.
