Dear Deputy Whitmore,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health and Children for response.

I can confirm that the Community Neuro Rehabilitation Team (CNRT) is operational within the Managed Clinical Rehabilitation Network for Dublin South and Wicklow since the 29th September 2025. There are 9 out of 12 posts in place and recruitment is ongoing for the Rehabilitation Consultant, Clinical Nurse Specialist and senior Psychologist.
