Dear Deputy Brabazon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question you submitted to the Minister for Health for a response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Coolock Primary Care Centre is located in the Integrated Health Area Dublin North County. It offers a wide range of integrated care services designed to support the health and wellbeing of the local community. The centre has four onsite gyms, which are used as part of treatment plans for clients referred to appropriate services. Following a clinical assessment and where gym sessions are indicated, bookings are made on a case-by-case basis by the treating clinician. There are no waiting lists once the assessment is complete.

Referrals can be made through GP's, Public Health Nurses and other Healthcare professionals, as well as via self-referral.
