HSE Dublin and North East has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

The MRI unit at Our Lady's Hospital, Navan is operated by Alliance Medical Diagnostic Imaging (AMDI) under a contract covering inpatients, outpatients, and the GP Access to Community Diagnostics scheme, with daily scans available to all patients based on clinical triage and prioritisation, including medical card holders. The arrangement forms part of the National Tender, with AMDI one of several approved providers, and the cost per scan is covered under this contract. Liability is covered by AMDI.



The MRI unit is operated through a public/private partnership that encompasses both HSE employs and private staff.

All medical card holders have access to all scans available under the GP Access to Community Diagnostics in the MRI unit. The full list of scans available to all patients under the GP Access to Community Diagnostics are outlined on the HSE website.
