The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for response.

In line with our response to previous PQ41470 dated 13th August 2025, please note that funding for the National Ambulance Service is allocated on a national and area basis, rather than a strict local one, as a result, the specific funding levels allocated to the St. Mary's Health Campus ambulance base, the Kinsale Road ambulance base and the Erinville bases are not separately identifiable.
