I wish to apologise for the delay in providing answer to your Parliamentary Question. This required engagement with each health area to ensure the most up to date information was provided in the reply.

The table below outlines the WTE filled and unfilled in each county as of September 2025. It should be noted that some unfilled posts may have been previously filled, and the incumbent left the post, leaving it vacant as of September 2025.
