I wish to advise you that the Business Intelligence Unit (BIU), HSE Planning and Performance has provided the data you have requested in the attached table as at June 2025. I am advised by the BIU that the requested 2020 comparative data is not available. I am advised that following an extensive Hospital Bed Management System (HBMS) audit which validated how hospital beds were reported, the data from January 2020 is not comparable and cannot be provided.
