## PQ 47980/25

To ask the Minister for Health when the vacant post of Ophthalmologist, providing a service at the County Clinic, Clonmel will be filled; when the successful applicant will take up duty; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Healy,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

I can confirm that the HSE engaged a full recruitment campaign for the Consultant Ophthalmologist in South Tipperary. An interview board was set up and interviews undertaken, the result of which was one successful candidate. The successful candidate was appointed to the post in late July 2025; however, due to personal circumstances, they subsequently declined the post before the commencement date.

I wish to advise that the HSE has undertaken a second recruitment campaign in the last number of weeks. The post was re-advertised on a temporary basis in the Irish College of Ophthalmologists. The closing date for applications is Thursday, 25/09/2025. In the meantime, patients can avail of Ophthalmology Services via the University Hospital Waterford, Ophthalmology Department.
