“To ask the Minister for Children; Disability and Equality the current average waiting times for a physiotherapy appointment at Monaghan CDNT; and if she will make a statement on the matter.” – Matt Carthy

Dear Deputy Carthy,

I refer to your parliamentary question above which has been referred to me for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Under the national Progressing Disability Services (PDS) model, CDNTs offer therapeutic support to children and young people (0-18 years) via an interdisciplinary model. Therefore, intervention is based on the overall intervention needs identified for children and young people on a CDNT caseload. CDNTs do not hold single discipline waiting lists as per the PDS model. There are standardised waiting list metrics captured monthly for all CDNTs in all six Health Regions across the country.

The below table outlines the number of children and young people, by waitlist times, waiting to access CDNT services in Monaghan as at 31st August 2025 as per the nationally agreed metrics collated:

Waitlist times	Numbers Waiting
0-3 months	20
4-6 months	29
7-12 months	24
12 months +	0
