Dear Deputy,

I refer to your recent Parliamentary Question which was sent to the HSE for response.

Staffing details by staff group and service are available through the Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC), which is the official employment count for the public health sector and routinely published here. Information on vacancies across acute and community services is not routinely collected at a national level in the manner sought so cannot be provided. Outlined in the tables below are the WTE staffing for the specified grades by Health Region at the end of each year from 2022 to 2024, in both Primary Care and Mental Health.
