## PQ48460/25

To ask the Minister for Health to provide a breakdown of the number of life-threatening calls that National Ambulance Service attended within 19-minutes in County Wexford in the first eight months of 2025; and if she will make a statement on the matter. -George Lawlor

Dear Deputy Lawlor,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for response.

All 999/112 calls received for emergency medical assistance are prioritised using an internationally recognised system that triages calls based on clinical priority, which range from life-threatening- cardiac or respiratory arrest to minor illness or injury.

The NAS utilises this system to ensure the best use of resources by tasking the nearest available ambulance to the highest priority incident.

In Q1 2025, the NAS responded to 85,935 emergency calls.
