Dear Deputy Collins

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The opening hours of all vaccination centres in the Mid-West region have been reduced over the last number of weeks in line with the fall-off in demand for the COVID-19 vaccine nationally.

The Limerick Vaccination Centre located at Scoil Carmel is currently operating four days per week. In addition, the vaccination centres in Ennis Hospital and the Abbey Court Hotel, Nenagh are currently open three days per week.

Nationally, the opening hours of all vaccination centres are currently under review and subject to change depending on service demands.
