1	Cllr Dave Quinn	Taking account of the recommendations contained within the Disability Capacity Review 2021 and the acknowledged importance of services to support families in the provision of Primary Care detailed in the National Housing Strategy for Disabled People 2022 and the acknowledged importance of Respite Services within the National Disability Action Plan Framework, in light of the ongoing practice of reallocating residential respite accommodation used by people with intellectual disabilities to the provision of emergency/crisis residential accommodation to people with intellectual disabilities, thereby removing respite services for very lengthy periods of time, we call on HSE to ring-fence and extend existing funding for residential respite accommodation services as well as make adequate increased separate funding available for the additional provision of emergency/respite residential accommodation required by people with intellectual disabilities – where such emergencies arise due to the ongoing and increasing need due to fatigue, ill-health, mental health crisis and death of the parents/carers of the person with intellectual disabilities. 
