Statement of Purpose	The purpose of CHAIR is to gather information on hospital patients admitted to hospitals with suspected or confirmed acute coronary syndromes (ACS) in order to improve the delivery of healthcare and to improve patient outcomes.
Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Record, describe and analyse registered patient demographics, diagnostic and treatment details and hospital outcomes. 2. Facilitate the development of strategies to improve the quality of ACS patient care. 3. Contribute towards the development of a national plan for the in-patient and community management of patients with ACS. 4. Provide data for the Heartbeat portal to support the National Office of Clinical Audit (NOCA) Irish Heart Attack Audit (IHAA).
Target Population	All patients admitted to hospitals in the South/South West Hospital Group, one private hospital and one voluntary hospital with suspected or confirmed acute coronary syndromes.

Governance and Management Structure	<p>The CHAIR Governance and Management Structure is currently under review.</p> <p>The current structure consists of a CHAIR Clinical Lead, nominated by the HSE SSWHG CEO, who makes strategic decisions in the relation to CHAIR. The CHAIR Programme Manager and executive team are responsible for development, implementation and reporting.</p> <p>The objective of the current governance and management re-structuring process is to establish a Governance Board which will make strategic decisions and oversee operational plans on behalf of CHAIR. The Governance Board will include relevant clinical and management stakeholders, patient representatives and representation from each of the CHAIR participating hospitals. The review is due to be completed in Q4 2023.</p>
