A Consultant at the referring hospital determines that a discussion with the MTC¹ is required.

Call 1800-TRAUMA @ 1800-872-862

The most appropriate senior clinician at the referring hospital calls the National Trauma Desk in the National Emergency Operations Centre.

Three-way call with the receiving MTC¹

The NEOC dispatcher initiates a call with the on-call trauma consultant +/- trauma coordinator +/- others, as required, to discuss the patient's condition and management priorities.

Collaborative decision on transfer of care

A collaborative decision on the appropriate management of the patient and their transfer of care needs is made by the referring hospital and the receiving MTC.¹

Planning for transfer

Where transfer of care to the MTC¹ is agreed, planning for the transfer is completed by NEOC, the referring hospital and the receiving MTC.¹

Transfer of care to the MTC if agreed

Where transfer of care to the MTC¹ is agreed, all appropriate documentation is completed, compiled and either sent to the receiving MTC¹ in advance or accompanies the patient.
