This initiative seeks to recognise and celebrate projects completed in the last **two years or currently ongoing** that have contributed to the HSE's journey towards Net Zero. Successful applicants will be awarded up to €5,000 to reinvest in an existing project or to establish a new initiative related to climate and sustainability.

Priority Areas

Applications are sought for projects aligned with the following priority areas, as outlined in the <u>HSE Climate Action</u> <u>Strategy 2023- 2050</u>:

- 1) Sustainable Buildings and the Green Environment
- 2) Transport and Mobility
- 3) Sustainable Procurement
- 4) Greener Models of Healthcare
- 5) Water and Waste Management
- 6) Adaptation and Resilience

Applications for other projects that demonstrate significant impact in climate and sustainability are also welcome.

Eligibility

- The lead applicant must be an employee of the HSE or Section 38 or 39 organisation.
- Applications must be made in respect a project completed within a HSE or Section 38 or 39 organisation.
- Project completed in the last two years or currently ongoing.
