1	Infants and children can deteriorate rapidly once they begin to tire					
2	The PEWS Score is the only reliable means of detecting a deteriorating child					
3	A child who is not improving may be at risk of deterioration

5	Clinical judgement is used to determine the appropriate response to clinical findings and level of concern					
6	The Escalation Guide must always be followed as prompted by the PEWS Score
