

COVID-19 Waste Management Standard Operating Procedure

28th April 2020, Version 1

This SOP sets out the waste management approach for all HSE hospitals and healthcare facilities (existing and temporary: testing centres, assessments hubs, step down facilities/field hospitals, self-isolation accommodations etc.) during the COVID-19 emergency response. A pragmatic approach will be implemented to ensure that waste is managed in a safe manner.

What does this mean for healthcare staff?

In summary, infectious COVID-19 healthcare risk waste is treated as regular Category B infectious waste in accordance with the national Healthcare Risk Waste Mgt: Segregation Packaging and Storage Guidelines for Healthcare Risk Waste 2010.

Waste arising from *possible or confirmed* COVID-19 cases are designated as infectious clinical waste (EWC code 18-01-03* whose collection and disposal is subject to special requirements in order to prevent infection). Segregate all waste from patients with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 as healthcare risk waste. Hands free (pedal operated) healthcare risk waste bins should be provided in isolation rooms and cohort areas.

Healthcare Risk Waste must be packaged into **UN-approved yellow bags** (in large yellow pedal bins) in accordance with the safe management of healthcare risk waste. Sharps, pharmaceutical, anatomical (excluded risk) waste should continue to be segregated into **UN-approved yellow rigid containers** with an appropriately coloured lid, and should not enter the UN-approved yellow bag stream.

- All those handling healthcare waste should wear appropriate PPE, and clean their hands after removing PPE. Once
 bagged, healthcare risk waste must be put into UN-approved yellow wheelie bins awaiting collection, treatment
 and energy recovery.
- External surfaces of waste containers/wheelie bins do not need to be disinfected. Please ensure that yellow
 wheelie bins are full for collection to prevent a wheelie bin shortage. When transporting UN-approved yellow
 wheelie bins Stericycle drivers wear disposable gloves, which are disposed of after each collection/location.
- All confidential waste must be put into confidential bins. **Confidential waste** from isolation wards should be stored for 72 hours prior to collection/shredding on site.
- Non healthcare risk waste (i.e. commercial/domestic) should be collected by the regular non-hazardous waste contractor for recycling and energy recovery. All food waste must be disposed of in compostable brown bags/bins/wheelie bins.
- All outer procurement packaging on equipment and products should be removed and recycled before an item is taken onto any ward or clinical area. If this packaging is taken into an isolation or higher risk area, then it is likely to become contaminated and therefore must be disposed as Category B infectious clinical waste.
- Clinical staff caring for people who are self-isolating in their own home are to leave their PPE behind in a bag, placed in a second plastic bag and stored in a secure location for 72 hours, before being put into their domestic waste stream. Relatives caring for people who are self-isolating are advised to follow the same guidelines.
