

Safer sexual sctivity – Snakes and ladders cards

(Print as many sets as required, laminate, cut into individual cards and sort into separate Snakes and Ladders piles before starting)



Gives respect and expects respect in every sexual relationship and activity.



Assumes that sexual activity seen on screen or in porn is wanted by a partner.



Always uses contraception when sexually active, to prevent an unplanned pregnancy.



Doesn't know anything about a partner's relationship and sexual history.



Talks about sexual preferences and boundaries with partner and agree activities.



Ignores ongoing disrespectful behaviour from a partner.



Gets tested, and if necessary, treated, for STIs if they have had unprotected sex.



Doesn't know their own and/or partner's STI/HIV status.



Pays attention to partner's words and body language to make sure that their sexual activity is consensual.



*Shares a partner's intimate photos online without permission.



Checks to make sure that sex is consensual and wants it to be pleasurable for both partners.



*Ignores the non-verbal signs that their partner may not really be into the sexual activity in which they're engaged.



Accesses emergency contraception and gets tested for STIs if at risk of unplanned pregnancy or contracting STIs.



Doesn't make a habit of carrying condoms, although they know there is a likelihood of having sex.



Uses condoms every time sexual activity involves a risk of pregnancy and/or STIs.



Doesn't bother with using a condom if a sexual partner looks healthy.



Thinks carefully about whether they are ready to get into a sexual relationship before making a decision.



Gossips with friends about the details of their sexual relationship - without their partner's consent.
