Measles

Symptoms:

- fever
 (temperature of 38°C or above)
- cough
- runny nose
- rash

 (usually appears on head and neck first and spreads to rest of body)

If you think you or your child has measles:

1. Phone your GP

2. Keep your child out of childcare or school

3. Get information by searching 'HSE measles'



Keep up to date with free vaccines

Vaccine 1: 12 months at GP

Vaccine 2: Junior infants (at school) or from GP (Sligo, Leitrim and Donegal)

GP and see immunisation.ie
