Successful HSE services will be advised on the week of the 14th August to ensure that funding is transferred within the September Rosetta budget transfer. Only fully completed application forms will be assessed.

Only 1 application per hospital or community service will be considered, budget codes must be provided for budget transfer by 25th August. Successful services that cannot provide a budget code by that date will not receive a grant. If there are more applications than grants, preference will be given to services who have not been successful previously.
