Normally the shelf life of our face shield products is 3 years. But this is not saying the function of protection will go away after 3 years, as it has much to do with the storage condition and the circumstance where it's used.

Before usage, the products need to be stored at room temperature in relative humidity does not exceed 80%, no corrosive gas, good ventilation, dry, clean environment, and kept away from solvents, or solvent vapors or any corrosive materials, as these may seriously reduce the impact protection and Anti fog effect provided by the Face shield.

when the warranty expires, the product may appear material discoloration, anti-fog attenuation, elastic aging and other phenomena, it is recommended to use up the product as soon as possible within 3 years, With the proper storage as above, it would be fine for the shelf life to be extended to one more year, and if this leads to quality issues, the customer shall evaluate its usage
