A Message from the Programme Director

To date the NiSRP Programme has delivered for over 62,000 staff members across the East, South-East, Mid-West, North-West and Midlands. This number will grow to over 80,000 when extended to staff in the South in March 2023. Huge credit is due to all of the staff and management around the HSE working really hard with the NiSRP Programme to ensure that all staff can have the benefits of Self Service and the single National Integrated Staff Records and Payroll systems as soon as possible.

Project Update

The NiSRP team are working closely with colleagues in HSE South and have conducted engagement sessions with management and staff. Local NiSRP Project Leads are in place and play a crucial role in both collecting local information and processes along with communicating any change impact on staff. A key stage in this implementation is to carry out parallel testing which includes two phases of testing the current live system against this new integrated system. The initial testing took place over the summer months and the next phase of testing is currently ongoing.

Programme Director, Ivan McConkey, said, "The team have already had positive engagement with staff and management in HSE South. I am confident that with further close collaboration with our colleagues in HSE South NiSRP will be successfully implemented in Spring 2023."

Here is a snapshot of some of their comments:



"No more annual leave cards"


"I would never go back to the paper way of submitting travel claims again"
