

Small Changes

- Adopt a multidisciplinary approach to pressure ulcer prevention
- Early pressure ulcer risk assessment (within 2 hours)
- Good compliance with risk assessment > 95%
- Safety Cross/Data collection system in place and local ownership of data
- Visual cues for high risk patients
- Safety briefings/includes update on “at risk” patients
- SSKIN Bundle and Communication Tool
- Equipment required is accessible/available
- Early recognition of Grade 1 pressure damage
- Able to differentiate between a pressure ulcer and a moisture lesion
- Staff understand the action required to standardise the approach to incontinence related skin care
- Patient and family engaged and involved in prevention and HAPU work co-partners
- Patient information leaflets
- MDT Education Sessions
- Pressure Ulcers to Zero information Board/Poster
