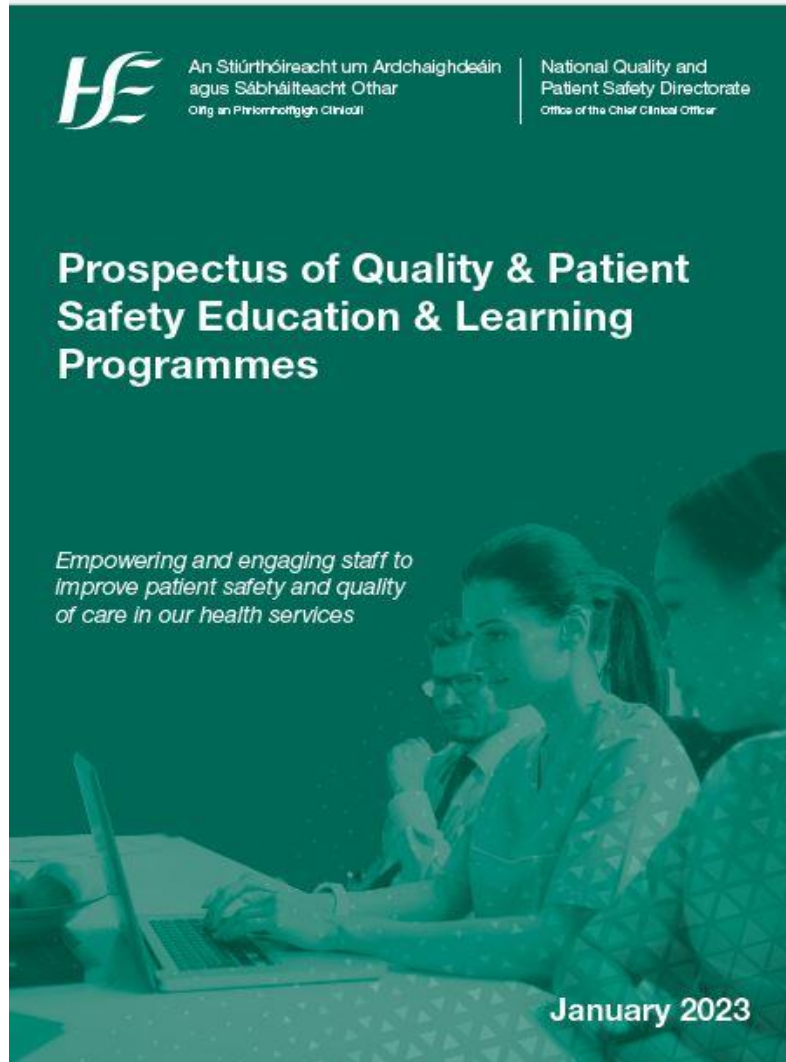

- Resources for further learning including Patient Safety Digest and QPS Community



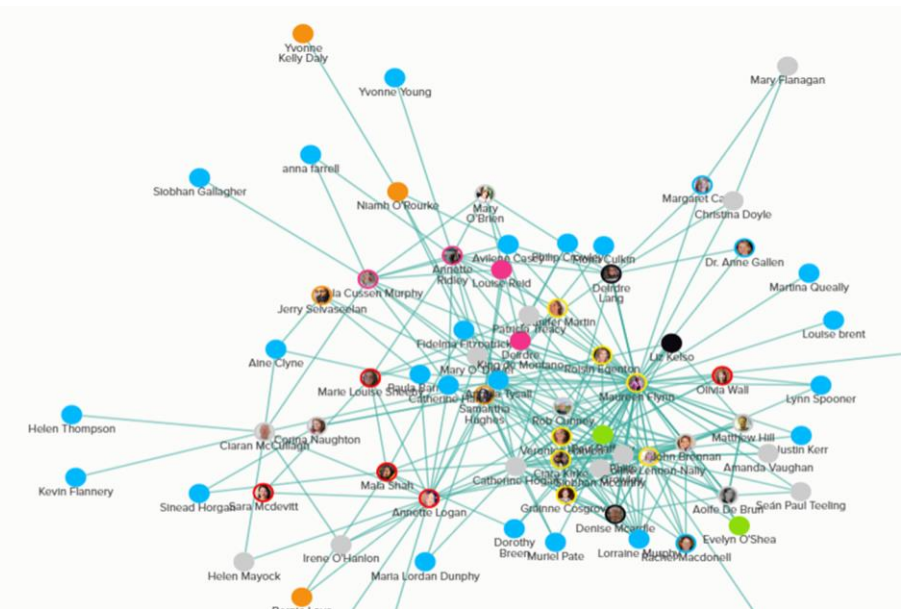

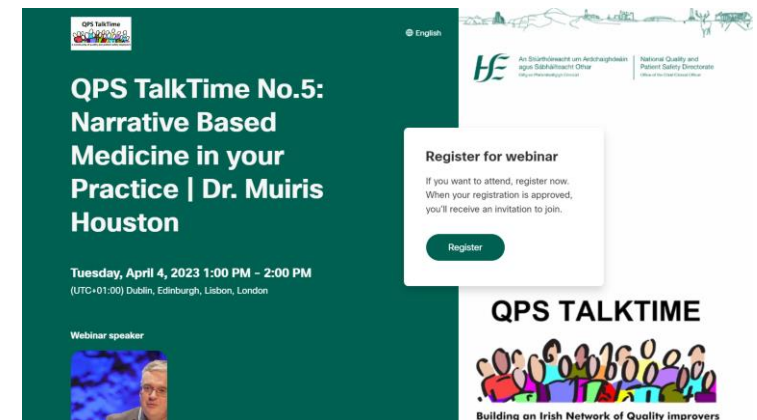
