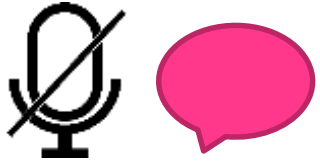

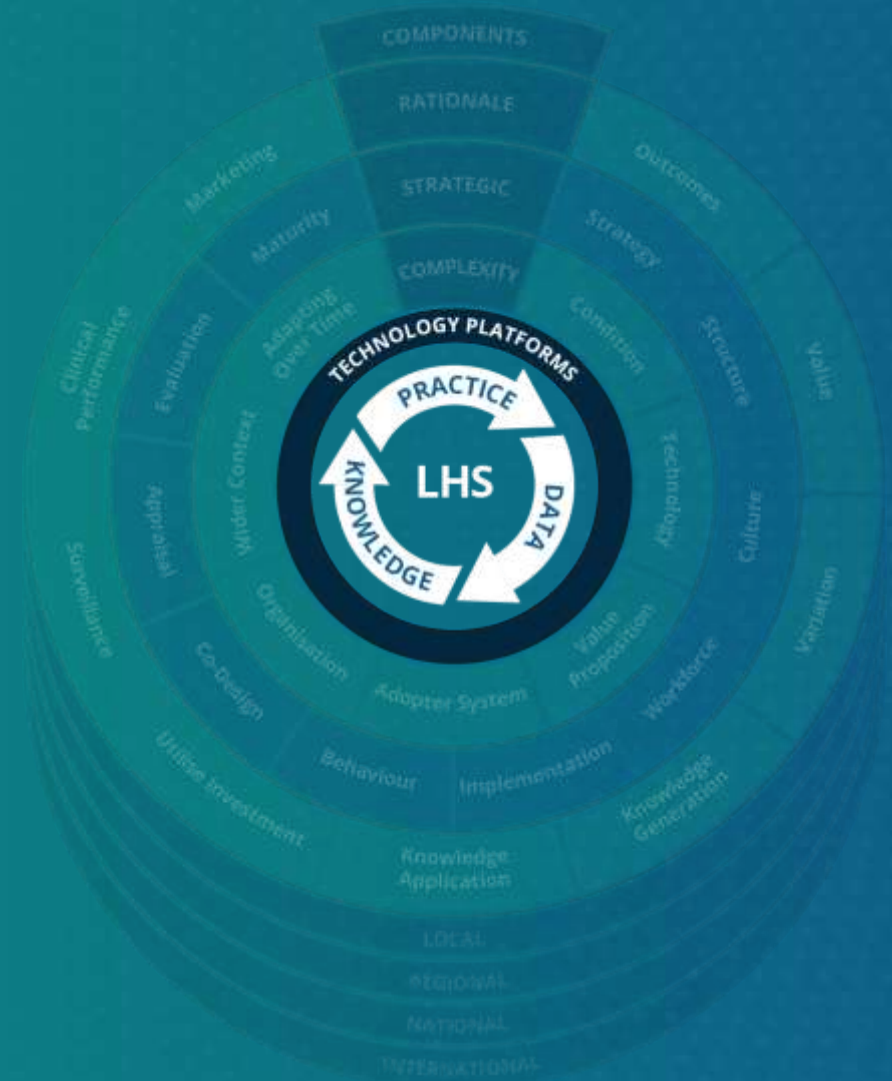

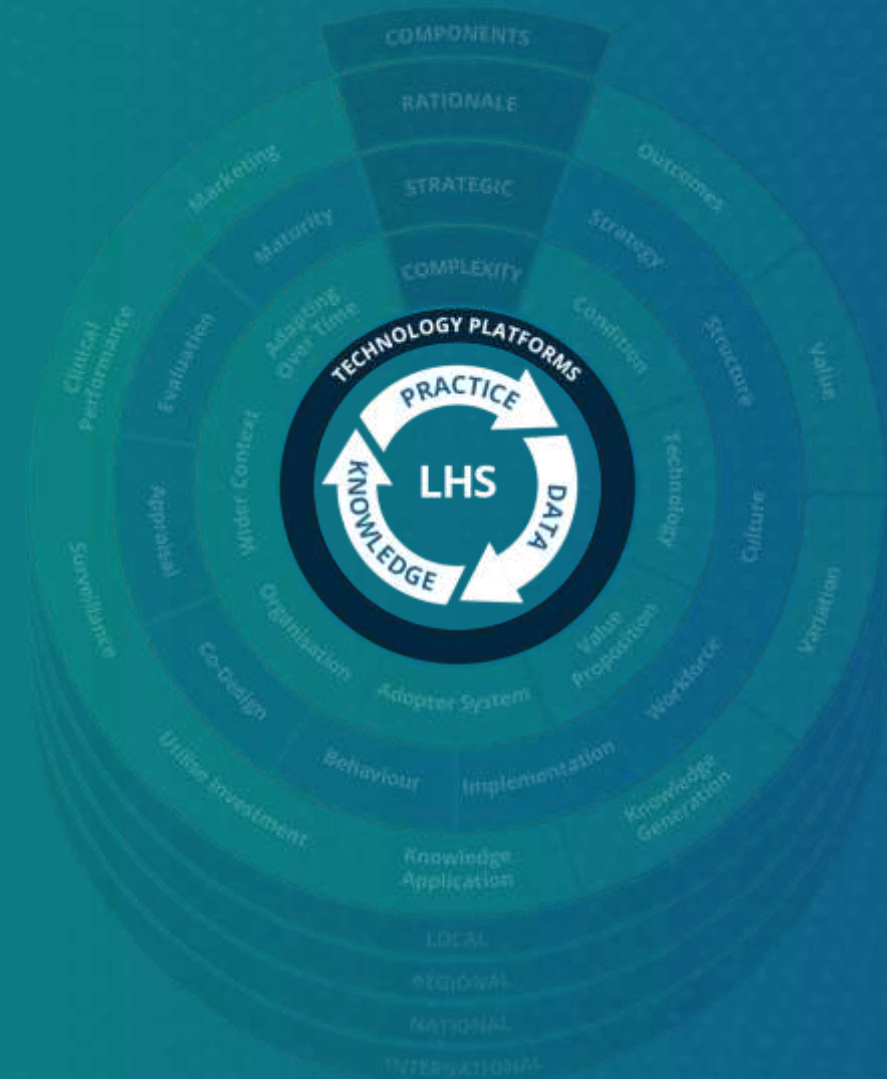

LEARNING COMMUNITIES

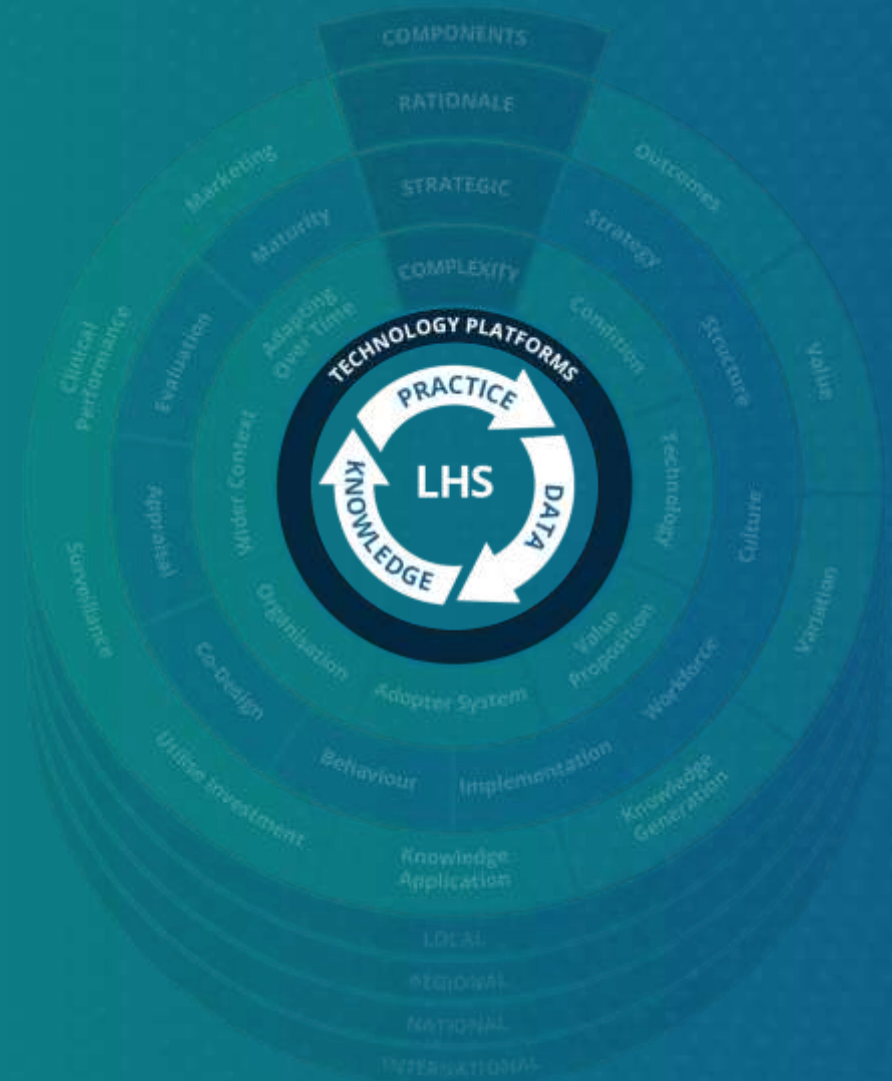
- Co-design terms of reference
