About NIMS Electronic Point of Entry (ePOE)

What is ePOE?

Benefits of ePOE:

- ▶ Eliminates duplication of work
- ▶ No licence fees
- ▶ Dedicated support team with no support fees
- ▶ Real time data on incident occurrences/ near-misses, initiates prompt for review & risk mitigation processes
- ▶ It is the data source for KPIs in patient safety
- ▶ User-friendly, intuitive, reliable system
- ▶ Eliminates common issue of illegibility in incident reporting

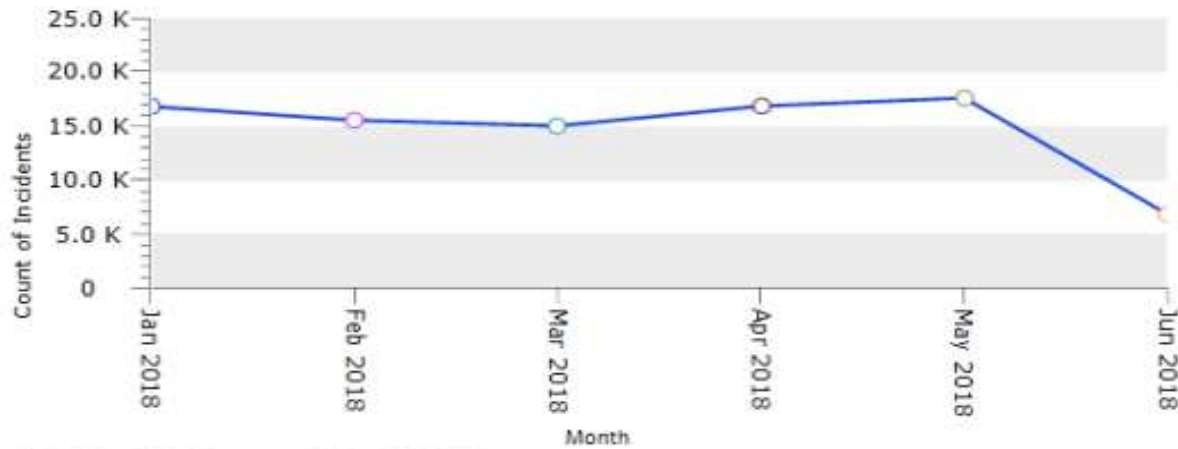

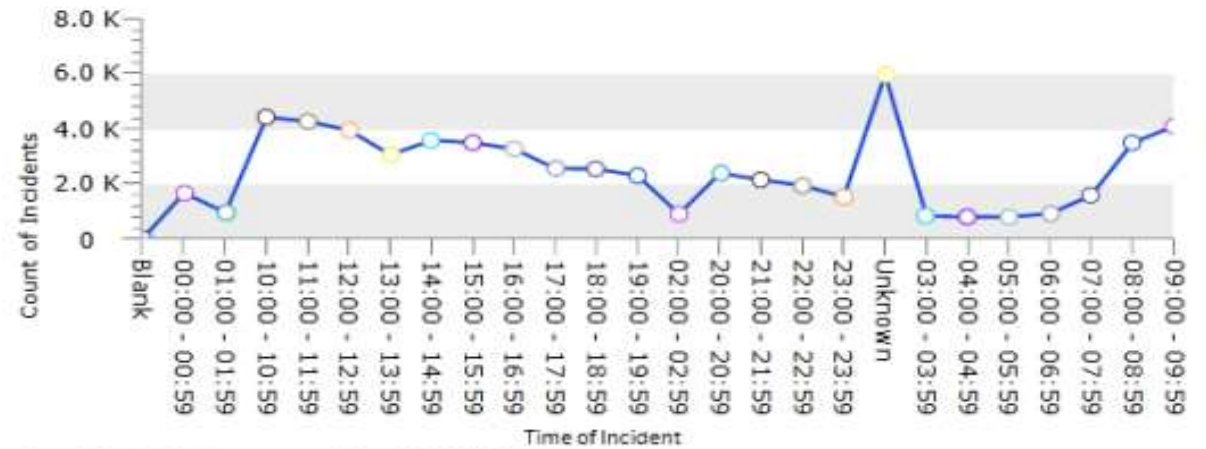

02. Incidents by Month of Incident Create Date (Line)



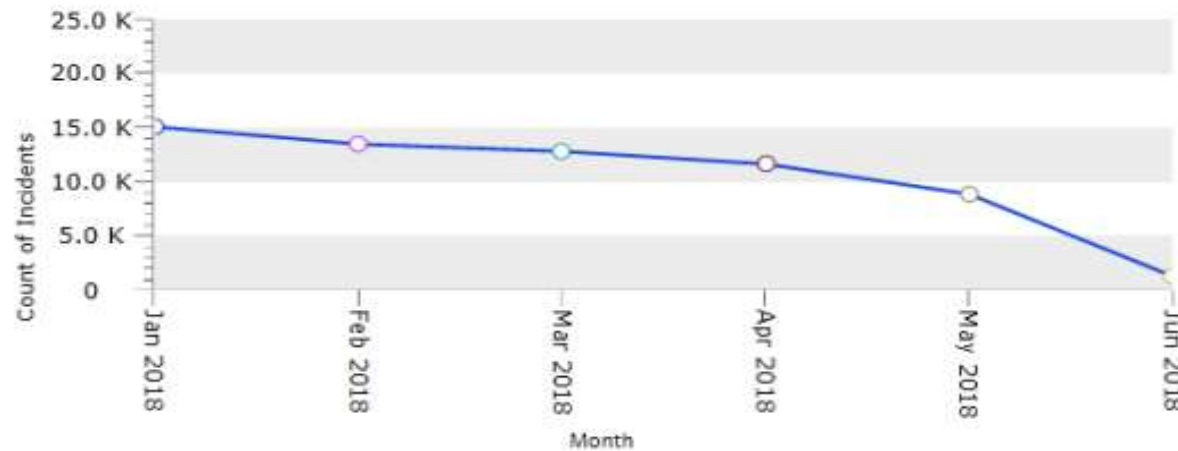
View: 1o Overall - All incidents created - YTD as of 18/06/2018

03. Incidents by Time of Incident (Line)



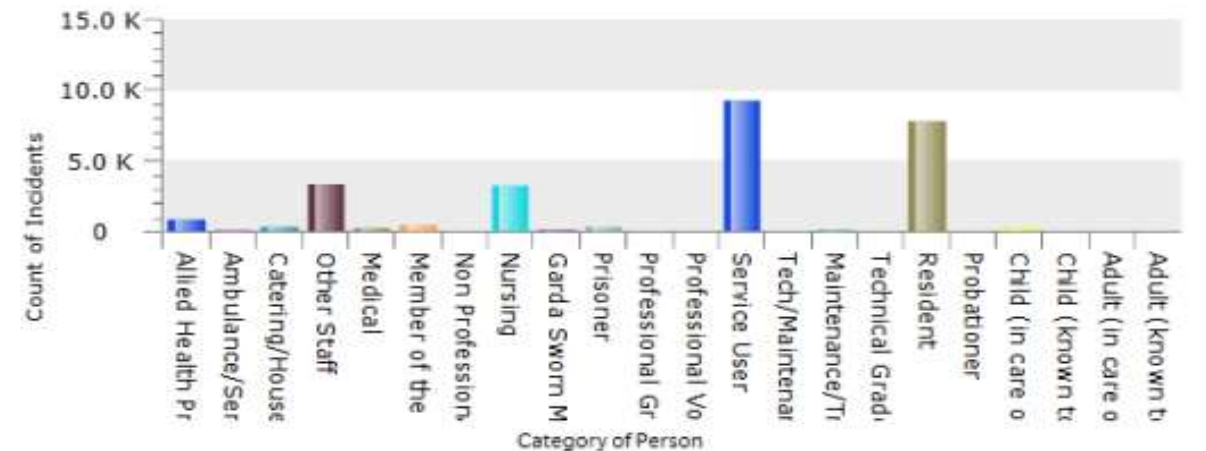
View: 1a Overall - All incidents occurred - YTD as of 18/06/2018

04. Incidents by Category of Person (Bar)

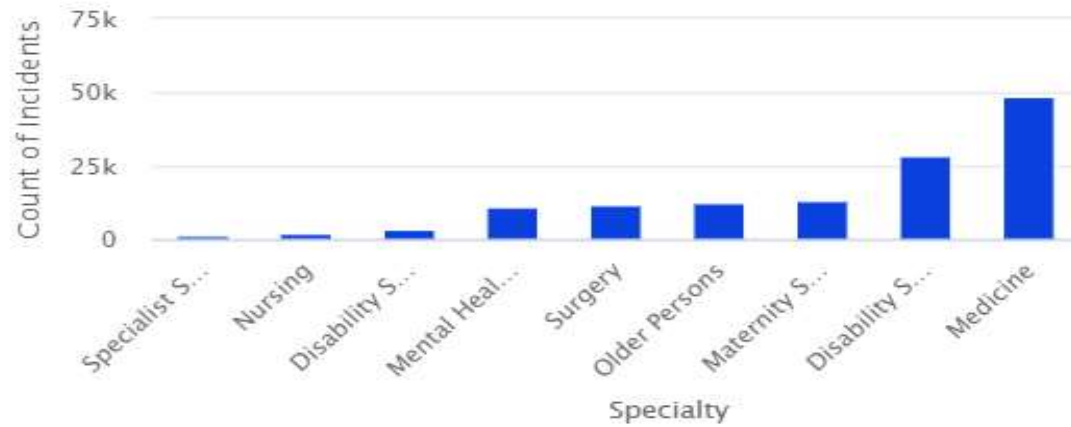


View: 3a Category - All Person Related incidents occurred - YTD as of 18/06/2018

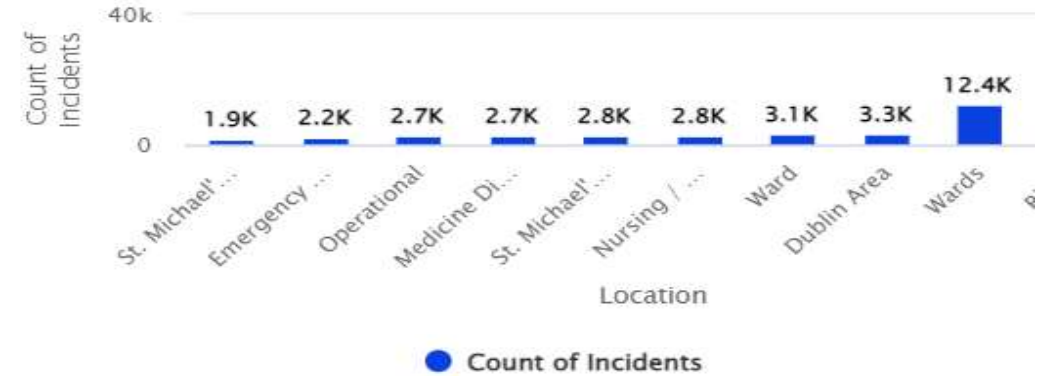

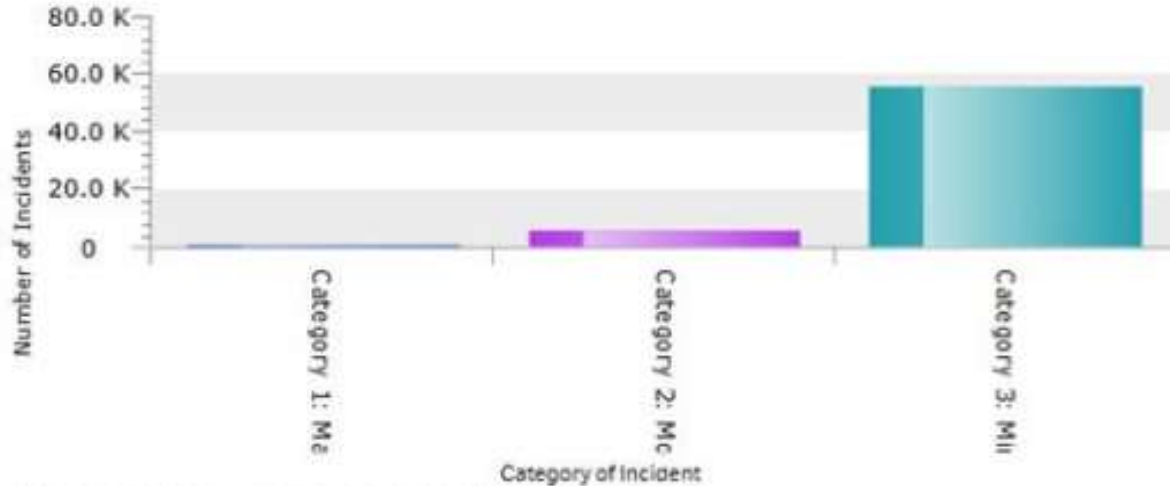
Incidents by Specialty Top 10 (Bar)



Incidents by Location Level F (Bar - Top 10)

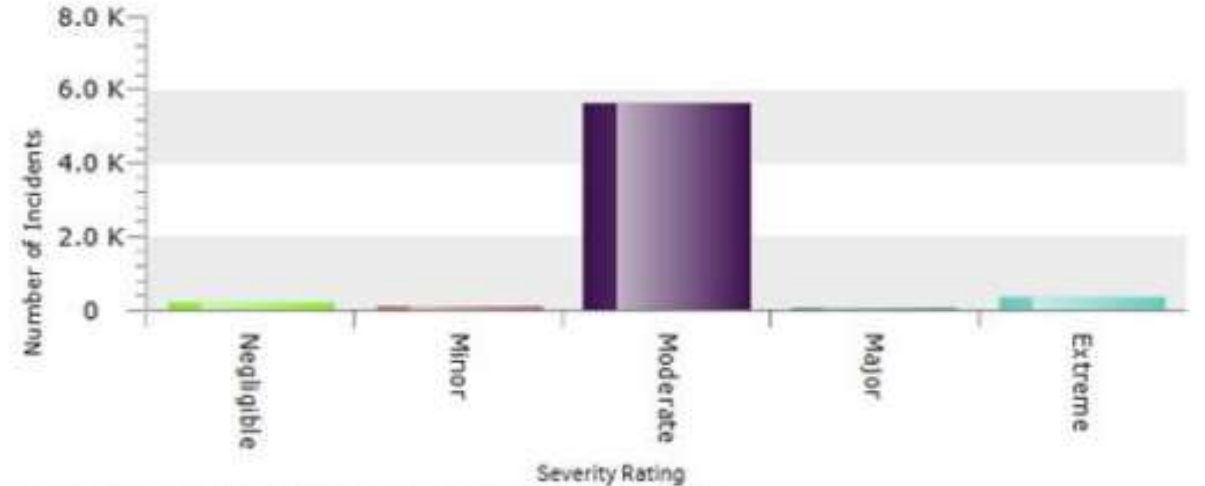


01. Incident reviews by Category of Incident 1,2,3

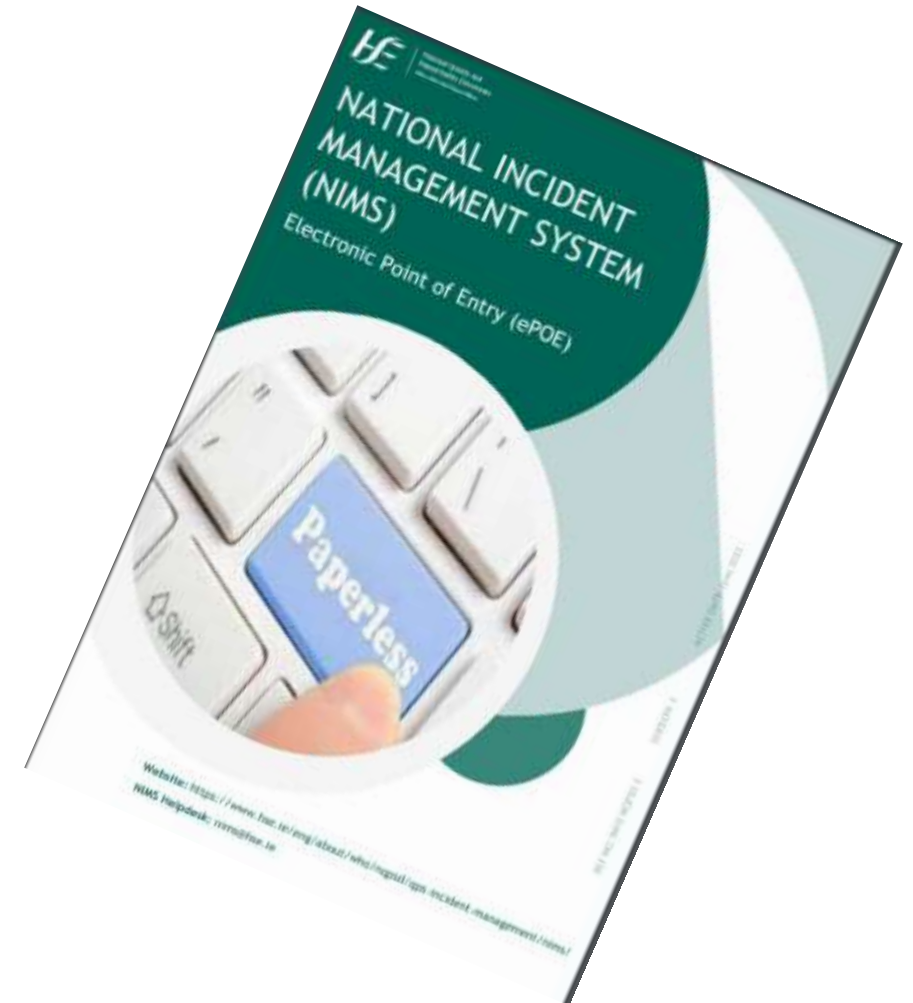

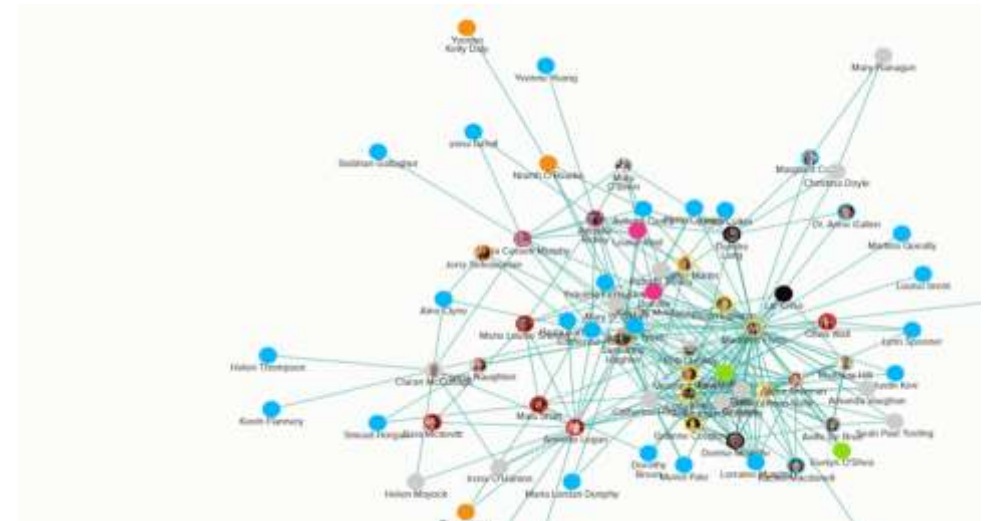

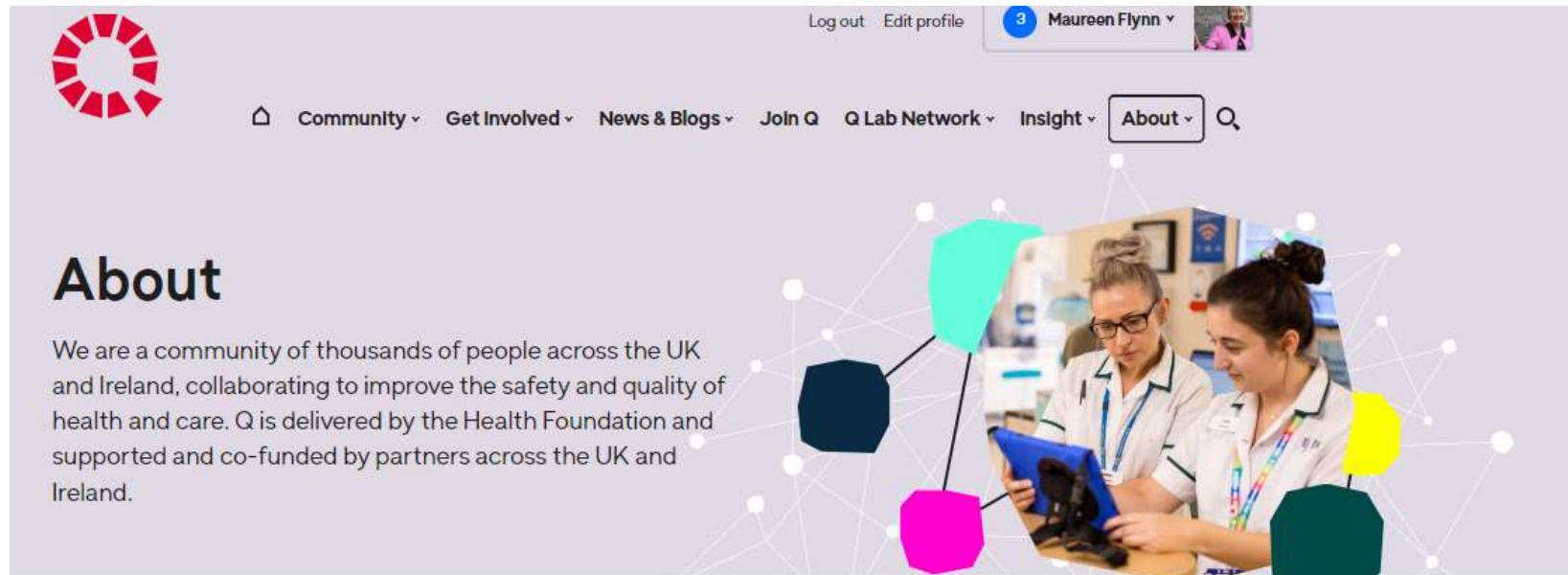
