About NIMS Electronic Point of Entry (ePOE)

What is ePOE?

Benefits of ePOE:

- Eliminates duplication of work
- No licence fees
- Dedicated support team with no support fees
- ▶ Real time data on incident occurrences/ near-misses, initiates prompt for review & risk mitigation processes
- ► It is the data source for KPIs in patient safety
- User-friendly, intuitive, reliable system
- Eliminates common issue of illegibility in incident reporting



- 6 episodes based on the Patient Safety Strategy themes.













The QPS Ireland Network Map


