Facilitated conversations about the emotional impact of our work


















Feel this is a very good meeting and hope to attend again.

Final Report of the Evaluation of the Introduction of Schwartz Rounds in Ireland Executive Summary | May 2019





'The environment I felt was safe, you could say what was on your mind, but the theme sometimes wasn't related to anything that we, I felt I'd anything to say about.' (FG2B)

'I think there are people who have come and didn't like it. I think we've encouraged people to give it a try, and if it's not for you, it's not for you. And I don't think it is for everyone, I think it's something that's personal...' (S102)

'I don't think I gained much myself, because I think I am who I am' (FG2A)









I just felt there was a connection with the panellist who was talking and not just the person I knew on the panel, but the others as well and when I finished you had to do that little questionnaire thing again and I was actually quite surprised by how moved I had been by the round' (S103)















'What Schwartz does is it allows people to connect with other people's experiences, I think that's the real value of Schwartz it's about connection and I think what surprised me about Schwartz was its not just about caring for patients it's about caring for staff and caring for each other.' (S210)





Draws all our awareness to the need for support for each other as we are all vulnerable in our roles working with people on a human level.

'I think in that way it's kind of helped people as well, deal with their emotions as well and to feel supported from the staff, knowing that they've actually gone through this experience' (FG1 B)
